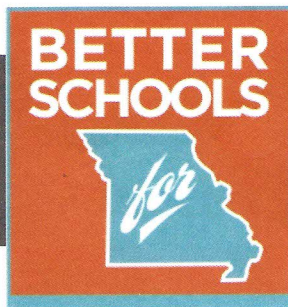

School Leaders Endorse Ken Wilson for State Representative

(Jefferson City, Mo) – Leaders and supporters of Missouri schools have endorsed Ken Wilson for State Representative in the 2014 general election for House District 12. Better Schools for Missouri is made up of a statewide coalition of school leaders and citizens that value public education. They endorse candidates for the Missouri General Assembly based on the candidate's support of public education, according to Superintendent Aaron Zalis from Rolla.
